What is 4all?

It is a voluntary database of children and young people with disabilities or additional needs aged 0-19 in Lincolnshire, and is part of the Family Information Service.

Lincolnshire County Council, like all local authorities in England, is required by the 1989 Children Act to hold an up-to-date list of children and young people with disabilities and additional needs in their area.

Anyone who is aged 0-19 can register if they consider themselves, or are considered, to have a disability or additional need.

What does 4all do?

Registration with 4all is completely voluntary and its main purpose is to provide statistics to both the local authority and other organisations to support the planning and development of services for families. Personal or identifiable information is never included in any reporting.

The benefits of registering

Once registered, the child or young person and their family will receive, and have access to a range of services:

- **a Welcome Pack** with useful bag and a range of information leaflets
- help with queries relating to disability issues and other family issues ranging from childcare to benefits, leisure to support groups
- regular copy of the 4All newsletter
- information and event updates
- **have an input** into the development of future services.
