


Welcome to Badgers Class Years 5 and 6, Spring Term 1

History **Victorians**

This term, students will engage in an in-depth exploration of the Victorian era, examining its societal, cultural, and economic transformations. Additionally, we will analyse key historical figures and events that shaped this period, fostering critical thinking and enhancing understanding of the complexities of 19th-century Britain.

Science

Properties of materials

This term, students will engage in an in-depth exploration of the properties of materials, including their physical and chemical characteristics. Through hands-on experiments and collaborative projects, learners will develop critical thinking skills while gaining a comprehensive understanding of material classifications and their applications in everyday life.

Maths

Multiplication and division / fractions / decimals

Children will develop their skills and concept of:

- Fractions
- Multiplication and division
- Multiplying 4 digits by 2 digits
- Long and short division
- Using the four operations when calculating using decimals
- Using mathematical reasoning to solve multi-step problems

- Develop performances in the style of music.
- Use an integrated approach to music through games, pulse, rhythm, pitch and playing instruments.

- Studying a range of artists.
- Using a variety of methods to create 2D pieces of art.
