### Hedgehogs Class

Over the next two weeks, Hedgehogs class are learning all about space. This links to our termly topic about Winter and Starry Nights. To launch our topic they played pass the parcel with a twist. In each layer a photo was hidden about the topic, this provided lots of discussion about what the children know or want to know. In the middle was a pile of non-fiction books all about Space for them to read. The children then voted on each photo about the topic they want to know more about. We then built a space station in the role play area which the children have thoroughly enjoyed piloting through space, narrowly missing planets on their journeys.



#### Squirrels Class

What a wonderful start to the Spring term. We have had some super discussions about our Christmas and the children have written fantastic recounts about their experience.

This week we have started our topic Bright Lights, Big City. We have identified the countries in the United Kingdom and named surrounding seas. We have also started our Science topic, Materials and their properties. We have collected and grouped examples of different materials and discussed their uses.



In Maths we have been recognising, making and adding equal groups. We then be making multiplication sentences from pictures and numbers.

#### Foxes Class

We have had a wonderful first week back after the Christmas holidays and the children have settled back into routine well. We have begun our narrative unit of The True Story of The Three Little Pigs where children have been using some fantastic vocabulary to build sentences.

Children also started their swimming sessions this week. Children behaved impeccably and they enjoyed their first session.

As part of our P.E unit last term, invasion games, we completed our final session this week. Children used all of the skills they learnt in a game of Bench Ball. They were so enthusiastic and showed a fantastic understanding of defending the ball!



#### Badgers Class

It was lovely to welcome all of Badgers Class back to school this week. I have been so impressed with the way they have settled back into class and are working hard in their lessons.

We have started a new topic this term called 'Blood Heart' which is all about the heart and the circulatory system. In the last few days we have learnt how to measure our own heart rate and facts about the heart. Yesterday, we spent time finding out about the different functions of blood. Badgers wrote their own questions and answers about blood and then turned these



onto 'fortune tellers' so they could ask each other lots of different questions about red and white blood cells, plasma and platelets.
