## Hedgehogs Class

This week we have been carrying on learning about Africa and the animals you can find there. The children have been so enthusiastic with this topic, we are having fantastic conservations and work produced. We have learnt what sounds the animals make, and looked closely at their skins and produced art work inspired by them. In maths, we are moving on to numbers 11-20 and finding different ways to represent them.



## Foxes Class

During English this week, we had our first experience day using our new writing scheme. In the classroom, we have welcomed our caterpillars, stick insect eggs and ants, as we watch their lifecycles develop.
