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#### **Aims**

Bythams Primary School is committed to:

- Increasing the extent to which disabled pupils can participate in the curriculum.
- Improving the physical environment of the school to enable disabled pupils to take better advantage of education, benefits, facilities, and services provided.
- Improving the availability of accessible information to disabled pupils.

#### Vision

Bythams Primary School has high ambitions for disabled pupils and expects them to participate and achieve in every aspect of school life. We promote equality of opportunity for disabled people: pupils, staff, parents, carers, and others who use the school.

# **Legislation and Guidance**

This plan meets the requirements of the Equality Act 2010 and the Department for Education (DfE) guidance for schools on the Equality Act 2010. The definition of disability includes physical or mental impairments that have a substantial and long-term adverse effect on the ability to undertake normal day-to-day activities.

## **Information Gathering**

- Initial information is gathered from parent meetings, induction meetings, and previous settings.
- Annual questionnaires are sent to parents to gather information on disabilities and how the school can help address the needs of the child.

#### **Main Priorities**

#### 1. Increasing Curriculum Access

- o Ensure all out-of-school activities are inclusive.
- o Provide specialist support where necessary.
- o Ensure classrooms are optimally organized to promote participation and independence.

## 2. Improving Physical Environment

- o Ensure all areas of the school are accessible to wheelchair users.
- o Provide pathways and ramps where necessary.
- o Ensure emergency evacuation plans cover pupils and adults with disabilities.

## 3. Improving Delivery of Information

- o Ensure information is available in accessible formats.
- o Seek the views of parents and carers on preferred methods of communication.
