Phonics overview

Below are the sounds the children are taught at each phase. The children will progress through each phase.

<u>In Phase 1 and 2, the children are taught the pure sounds of the letters of the alphabet and they learn about segmenting and blending the sounds verbally.</u>

In Phase 6, the children are taught about regular and irregular spelling patterns such as adding ed or ing to words.
